What is CAMS Club Challenge Australia?

Club Challenge Australia is a one day team Hillclimb event, open to all CAMS Affiliated 'Sporting' Car Clubs. Clubs are encouraged to enter a team of three to five to compete at their state event on their behalf, with the top three teams taking home a cash prize for their club!

Why did CAMS create Club Challenge Australia?

Club Challenge Australia was developed as part of a larger club engagement strategy around CAMS engaging better with affiliate clubs and their members. Most importantly, we wanted to do something that gave back to our car clubs - hence the reasoning behind a low cost entry and the offering of generous prize money for the winning clubs (with a plan on building it into the largest prize pack for clubs to win in Australia).

We feel that we are in a unique position to offer an event of this nature.

What is the aim of Club Challenge Australia?

Our aim is simple - to create the largest grassroots team motor sport competition in Australia.

Where are the events held?

The events will be held across Australia giving every club in every state the ability to be represented. Pending the success of the event in each state, there are plans on it culminating in the best clubs from state qualifiers, travelling to one location for an all-out clash for ultimate bragging rights as the fastest club in Australia.

Who is eligible to enter?

All current CAMS Affiliated 'Sporting' Clubs are eligible to enter a team of five to compete on their behalf. Team members must be current and financial members of their respective club for 2018 and must hold a CAMS Speed Junior Licence or higher to compete.

When do entries open and close?

Entries for the Mt Cotton round are open August 20, 2018 and close 6pm, September 20, 2018.

How do I enter a team?

Each team member can enter online via CAMS website by clicking here.

Each team must also appoint a team manager to submit the team entry form on behalf of their club. Entries are only final once all steps have been completed.

What is the entry fee?

The entry fee is \$300.00 per club, payable online via CAMS website.

This fee includes lunch for each competitor and event vehicle decals.

What is the prize money?

The prize money for the CAMS Club Challenge Australia, Jack's Hill is as follows:

How does scoring work?

The competitor's best time for the day will be divided by the class record for the class he/ she is running in.

The class record will be taken as it stands at the beginning of the day's competition.

This will then be multiplied by 100 to obtain a percentage.

For Example: Best time: 38.33s | Record: 37.21s $38.33 / 37.21 \times 100 = 103\%$

The percentages for each team member will be added together and divided by the number of participants per team (5) to determine the overall team percentage. The team with the lowest percentage at the end of the event will be the CAMS Club Challenge winner. In the event of a tie, the prize money will be split as determined by event organisers.
