

TYRE SUPPLY EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

CAMS Australian Formula 4 Championship – 2018

The Confederation of Australian Motor Sport is the governing body of motor sport in Australia. CAMS authorises championships in all disciplines of regulated Australian motor sport and is the owner of the Intellectual Property Rights of the above Championship title.

CAMS invites responses to this Expression of Interest (**EOI**) from interested parties for the provision of a control tyre for 2018 and beyond for the CAMS Australian Formula 4 Championship (**Championship**).

2018 Calendar

The Championship will be run over six (6) or seven (7) round championship conducted at major Australian motor sport events throughout the calendar year.

TV Package

An appropriate television schedule will be negotiated, which will incorporate a television package to be produced for each round of the Championship.

Eligible Vehicles

Only cars homologated as FIA Formula 4 cars are eligible to participate in the Championship.

Volume

Four (4) slick tyres will be available for competitors to compete with at each event for the free practice sessions, qualifying sessions and races. When conditions require, wet-weather tyres may be used.

Specifications

The wheel size for the Championship is:

Minimum/Maximum complete front wheel width: 200 mm /250 mm

Minimum/Maximum complete rear wheel width: 240 mm /290 mm

Wheel bead diameter: 330 mm (+/- 2.5 mm).

These measurements will be taken horizontally at axle height.

Support

The tyre supplier will be required to provide on-track fitting, balancing and technical services support. The supplier must be professionally presented, including support vehicles and personnel, and must be located within the designated Formula 4 paddock area at all meetings.

Testing

The tyres may be subject to testing and evaluation as determined by CAMS. The respondents will be required to supply an agreed number of tyres prior to testing and can have technical representatives on site.

Retail

The quoted sale price of the tyres will represent the total price including fitting tyres, stripping rims and removing old tyres, inclusive of GST.

Marketing Opportunities

As part of the financial consideration to CAMS, the successful tyre supplier will have the following marketing benefits.

- To be listed as the Official Tyre Supplier to the Championship
- Company logo on the front and rear wing end plate
- Signage in the Championship paddock area at all race meetings
- Company logo on the Championship website and links to the successful tenderer's own site
- Company logo on the Championship backdrop
- Company logo on apparel of CAMS appointed Championship officials
- Sponsorship and media opportunities (including major partnership with the category)

Term

CAMS would be interested in receiving submissions on a minimum three (3) year arrangement.

Considerations

- A financial consideration to be paid each year to CAMS for the control tyre sanction rights
- Purchase cost per tyre being favourable to the competitor base
- On-track distribution and support
- Supply of tyres for CAMS Formula 4 car when used for public / promotional opportunities and / or CAMS Driver Development Academy

Note: Championship major sponsorship rights are also available from 2018. Tyre suppliers are invited to factor this in to their submission.
