RATIONALE

The CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, General Requirements for Cars and Drivers Schedule D Apparel, is amended to revise the requirement for a Balaclava in the Off Road discipline. This amendment will apply the requirement to wear a Balaclava for any Open Face Helmet and for a Helmet that is listed in Level B for participants in Off Road.

ACTION

The CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, General Requirements for Cars and Drivers Schedule D Apparel, is amended and effective from **3 February 2017** as follows:
